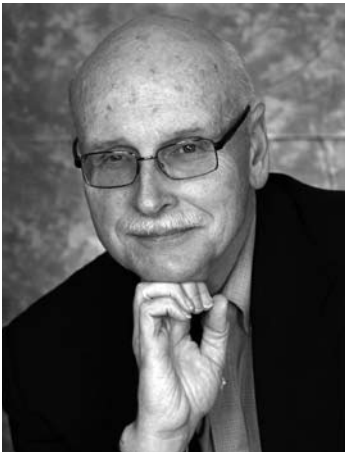

At first it was difficult for Bill to book guests for a 6 a.m. taping, but after years of perseverance and hard work Bill became well known in the field of personal development. *The Secrets of Success* now receives requests from both national and international authors. In addition to hosting his own show, Bill, an attorney for over 30 years, is a frequent guest and lecturer on other shows on the subject of real estate and mortgage financing. After 20 years and over 1,000 shows Bill states, "I still find each show I host exciting thanks to a variety of fascinating guests and the spirited people at WHPC that make the show possible."

STUDENT SPOTLIGHT: EMILY BARRETT

Emily Barrett transferred to Nassau Community College in the spring of 2008 and much to her surprise found her true calling; WHPC.
