

CAPP - Glossary of Terms

Additional Information	Lists courses taken that are not used by the evaluation that was run (Leftover courses)
Area	Represents sub-components of the requirements for a degree program
Attribute	Identifies special characteristics of courses used to define program requirements
CAPP	Acronym for Curriculum, Advising and Program Planning. Tracks the student's progress toward a degree.
Catalog Term	The catalog used to check the requirements
Condition	Defines the relationship among requirements. If a course on the list must be completed, it is designated as an "and" condition. If there is a choice of courses that may be completed, they are designated as an "or" condition.
Degree Evaluation	Process of running an evaluation in the Student Information System. Checks coursework against degree requirements and generates a report of the results.
Detail Requirements	Lists the specific requirements as met or not met and the courses/credits meeting the requirements (Recommended)
Evaluation Term	Term in which evaluation is run (Should be current term)
General Requirements	Displays NCC's minimum requirements to graduate. Also displays courses/credits that have met each of the areas for the degree program.
Generate New Evaluation	Request a new evaluation to be run on a student's current program
In Progress	Courses a student has enrolled in that have not yet been graded. In-progress courses will have a source of "R" and a blank for a grade within the Detail Requirements page and are indicated as an "*" asterisk on the General Requirements page. Each evaluation assumes the student will successfully complete the in-progress courses.
Low/High	Indicates a range of course numbers that can be taken
Met/Not Met	Indicates the requirements for a program and/or area that have or have not been satisfied
Overall GPA	Grade point average for all courses taken at NCC
Previous Evaluation	View previous evaluations that were generated
Program	The major a student is working toward
Program GPA	Ignore - Not used at NCC
Result as of	Date the degree evaluation was generated
Rule	Indicates that the requirement includes multiple components or is a choice among several courses
Source	Where a student's courses originated; H=Academic History at NCC, R= Registered or in-progress and T= transfer
Unused/Used	Indicates the number of credits/courses not used or used by the degree evaluation
What-If-Analysis	To see what courses apply and what courses are needed to complete a degree other than the one in which the student is enrolled
