PURPOSE

The College welcomes and encourages members of the community and other interested persons to visit the College. However, because the College is a place of work and learning, certain limits must be set for such visits.

SCOPE

This policy is binding on all visitors.

DEFINITIONS

Visitor: Anyone who is not an employee, student, volunteer or a member of the Board of Trustees of Nassau Community College shall be considered a visitor.

POLICY

The President, or his/her designee, is responsible for all persons on the College Campus. For these reasons, the following rules apply to visitors to the College:

- A. All visitors are required to abide by all College policies and procedures.
- B. Any visitor to the Campus may be required to show a valid photo identification card upon request.

ENFORCEMENT

Violation of this policy may result in visitors being directed to leave the Campus. Refusal to leave the Campus will result in the Nassau County Police being contacted.
