Topics: What Grows on the Farm, Farm Animals & Halloween

<u>Cognitive Development:</u> We will talk about:

- What is a farm? What happens on a farm? Why are farms important?
- What grows on the farm?
- What animals live on the farm? Why they are important? Talk about the foods they provide for us.
- How do pumpkins grow? Describe how a pumpkin looks and feels inside and out.
- talk about the holiday of Halloween.
- Introduce the letters Ee, Ff, Gg, Hh, Ii, Jj, Kk and Ll.

Music:

 "Old MacDonald Had a Farm", "Down on Grandpa's Farm", "Five Little Pumpkins" and "If Your Scared and You Know It" Fine Motor Skills/Self Help Skills:

- Practice buttoning, zipping and snapping.
- Practice putting on coat and shoes.

Social/Emotional Development:

- Pretend play -
 - go apple picking
 - work/shop at a farmers market

(dramatic play area will be transformed into a farmers market)

Gross Motor Skills:

- Climbing up the rock wall on the playground.
- Using wheelbarrows to move pumpkins around on the playground.

- Week of Oct. 16th the playground will be transformed into a pumpkin patch.

Writing Center

• Trace numbers.

<u>Math Center</u>

- Using a variety of math games to reinforce concepts.
- Sort farm animals/match baby animals to their mothers.

<u>Science Center</u>

- Scales and weights how heavy is the apple? Use scales to compare different apples/apples to other items.
- Use a variety of science games to reinforce concepts.
- Use a magnifying glass to explore the inside of a carved pumpkin, the inside of an apple, and fall leaves.

<u>Art</u>

- Farm Animal Collage.
- Make a cow to add to the Big Barn Mural (to hang in the preschool gym).
- As a group, we will make horses to add to the mural.
