He conducted 400+ combat missions during two tours in Iraq, receiving the Combat Infantryman's Badge and a Purple Heart for shrapnel wounds resulting from a large IED explosion. He was honorably discharged in 2006. Matthew now serves as a detective with the NYPD in the elite, three-member forensic artist unit. Detective Klein's primary focus is creating the likeness of suspects for "wanted posters" when there is no surveillance footage by interviewing witnesses. His forensic sketches have resulted in many perpetrators being brought to justice. Join us for this interesting presentation on another example of careers and opportunities in the art field.
