Determined, Latifa entered Nassau Community College and earned a degree in Business Management which helped her secure a new position for herself. While working at her new position she realized she really enjoyed aspects of the legal side of her responsibilities. Since her law classes were her favorite classes at NCC, Latifa decided to pursue a law degree. Determined not to find herself in the same predicament again, Latifa chose to propel her career forward by returning to Nassau Community College to pursue a Certificate in Paralegal Studies. With the assistance of the Paralegal Program Coordinator, Latifa has already secured a position with a local law firm! She plans on working her way through law school!

NCC's *Paralegal Certificate Program* is approved by the **American Bar Association** and is open to students who have either an Associate or Baccalaureate degree. Students with an Associate degree must meet the minimum general education requirements set by the American Bar Association. The program will accept a maximum of 9 credits of paralegal specialty transfer credits. Paralegal students are required to complete a minimum of 10 paralegal credits in the traditional format at NCC. Some students use the certificate as a

stepping stone to law school, while others take advantage of NCC's affordability and the insight the program provides into the rigors of studying law, before committing their time and expense to a legal education. Other students are exploring career changes or re-entering the job market. Whatever path a student pursues, a certificate in paralegal studies opens doors and creates options. **Weekend College** courses make opening those doors easier and more practical.
