Follow the sign for Charles Lindbergh Boulevard/Museum Row & merge onto Charles Lindbergh Blvd. Turn right at first entrance for the East Campus or at the first traffic light for the West Campus. Both entrances lead into the NCC parking lots.

NORTHERN STATE PARKWAY – to Meadowbrook Parkway South (Exit 31A/Jones Beach). Meadowbrook Parkway to Exit M4-Hempstead/Coliseum. Follow the sign for Charles Lindbergh Boulevard/Museum Row & merge onto Charles Lindbergh Blvd. Turn right at first entrance for the East Campus or at the first traffic light for the West Campus. Both entrances lead into the NCC parking lots.

SOUTHERN STATE PARKWAY – to Meadowbrook Parkway North to (Exit 22N – Mineola) Meadowbrook Parkway to Exit M4 (Hempstead/Coliseum). Follow signs for Coliseum. Turn right at first entrance for the East Campus or at the first traffic light for the West Campus. Both entrances lead into the NCC parking lots.

MANHATTAN - Queens Midtown Tunnel (34th Street & 2nd Avenue) to Long Island Expressway (L.I.E.) East (495). Take L.I.E. East to Northern State Parkway East. Northern State Parkway East to Meadowbrook Parkway South (Exit 31A/Jones Beach). Meadowbrook Parkway to Exit M4-Hempstead/Coliseum. Follow the sign for Charles Lindbergh Boulevard/Museum Row & merge onto Charles Lindbergh Blvd. Turn right at first entrance for the East Campus or at the first traffic light for the West Campus. Both entrances lead into the NCC parking lots.

Applications for admissions are processed on a rolling basis. Degree-seeking students apply through the Office of Admissions and non-degree seeking students apply through the Office of the Registrar. Application completion deadlines are as follows: Fall Semester, August 14; Spring Semester, January 5; Summer Semester, May 31. Degree-seeking applicants may need to participate in the placement testing which occur as follows: For Fall Semester, between March – August; for Spring Semester, between October – January; for Summer Semester, between March – May.

Students interested in Programs with limited space (i.e. Nursing, Allied Health Science programs, Culinary Art, Fashion Apparel Design, Mortuary Science, and Studio Recording Technology) must review the Program and Admission Requirements chart available through our website or through the Office of Admissions. These programs have additional admission requirements and application deadlines which differ from those listed above.
