2. Budget - Additional State Aid

WHEREAS, BUDGETED STATE OPERATING AID FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2011 – 2012 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$41,546,390 WAS BASED ON THE PER FTE AID AMOUNT APPROVED BY THE STATE AFTER THE CUTS AND BEFORE PARTIAL RESTORATION BY THE STATE LEGISLATURE. BASED ON THE PARTIAL RESTORATION OF THE PER FTE AID AMOUNT BY THE STATE LEGISLATURE, 2011 – 2012 STATE OPERATING AID INCREASED IN TOTAL BY THE AMOUNT OF \$839,167 WITH NO INCREASE IN THE TOTAL 2011 – 2012 OPERATING BUDGET;

**RESOLVED,** THAT THE NASSAU COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES HEREBY APPROVES AN INCREASE IN 2011 – 2012 STATE OPERATING AID IN THE AMOUNT OF \$839,167 FROM \$41,456,390 TO \$42,295,557 WITH NO INCREASE IN THE TOTAL OPERATING BUDGET;

## 3. Capital - Establishment of a Separate Grant Fund

As part of the agreement with Beacon Wireless, NCC will be paid a onetime sign-up fee for each carrier in the amount of \$25,000 and an annual payment of \$15,000 per carrier (which escalates at 3% per year). This revenue is eligible for state matching funds under the SUNY Capital Program for Community Colleges. In order to account for this revenue properly, a separate grant fund will need to be established. As funds are used for projects, the state reimbursement will be added to the fund and used to fund additional efforts.

WHEREAS, NASSAU COMMUNITY COLLEGE HAS SIGNED A CONTRACT WITH BEACON WIRELESS CONCERNIGN LEASING OF COLLEGE PROPERTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTION OF A CELL TOWER IN EXCHANGE FOR PAYMENT FROM BEACON, AND

WHEREAS, SUNY RECOGNIZES THIS REVENUE FROM BEACON WIRELESS AS FUNDS WHICH ARE ELIGIBLE FOR STATE MATCHING FUNDS THROUGH THE STATE CAPITAL PROGRAM FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGES, AND

WHEREAS, THIS REVENUE NEEDS TO BE ACCOUNTED FOR SEPARATELY FROM OTHER FUNDS TO ENSURE PROPER FINANCIAL ACCOUNTING, THEREFORE,

**BE IT RESOLVED**, THAT THE NASSAU COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES APPROVES THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SEPARATE GRANT FUND TO ACCOUNT FOR REVENUE TO NCC FROM THE BEACON WIRELESS CELL TOWER LEASE.
