## 6) Minimum Wage Increase

**Whereas,** the hourly rate of pay for Nassau Community College student aides and federal work study employees is \$13.00 per hour for on- and off-campus employment; and

Whereas, the Federal minimum wage is \$7.25 per hour effective July 24, 2009, pursuant to the Federal minimum wage provisions contained in the fair labor standards act (FLSA); and

Whereas, states also have minimum wage laws, where some state laws provide greater employee protections; and

**Whereas**, New York State minimum wage increased on December 31, 2020 from \$13.00 to \$14.00 and on December 31, 2021 to \$15.00; and

Whereas, employers must comply with both laws; and

Whereas, a student must be paid at least the Federal minimum wage under the Federal Work Study Program as required by 34 CFR 675.24(b), and under 34 CFR 675.20(c), the student's work must also be governed by employment conditions including pay, that are appropriate in terms of, among other things, the applicable federal, state, or local law; and

**Whereas,** government institutions are not subject to the provisions of the State's Minimum Wage Act, pursuant to the state regulation 12 NYCPR section 142-2.14(b); and

Whereas, Nassau Community College is committed to provide opportunities at competitive rates to Nassau Community College students participating in the Federal Work Study Program or employed as student aids; and

**Be It Resolved,** that the Nassau Community College Board of Trustees Finance and Capital Committee recommends that the full Board of Trustees authorizes the increase in the hourly rate of pay for Nassau Community College student aides and Federal Work Study employees to \$14.00 effective December 31, 2020 and \$15.00 effective December 31, 2021 for on- and off-campus employment.
