

# Nassau Community College Enrollment Checklist

# 1. Apply for Financial Aid

Online filing is available at <a href="www.fasfa.ed.gov">www.fasfa.ed.gov</a>. NCC's FAFSA School Code 002873 and NYS TAP Code is 2113. Click here for more information.

## 2. Submit Your Immunization Records

If your immunization records have not been submitted, you will need to provide documentation for measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) immunizations. In addition, you will need to complete the Meningitis Form. Failure to do so may result in you being withdrawn from your classes, per federal law. Download the Meningitis form by clicking here.

# 3. Submit Final Academic Transcripts

All final official college and high school transcripts MUST be submitted to the Office of Admissions by the first day of the semester. Failure to submit these documents will result in a block on your account that can impact your class registration and the disbursement of your financial aid. If you have taken any Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB), be sure to submit your scores to Admissions for review. If you earned college credit in high school, official college transcripts should also be submitted.

## 4. Pay Your NCC Tuition Bill.

## 5. Meet With an Academic Adviser

## 7. Your NCC Student ID Card

As soon as you have registered and paid for classes you can obtain your ID. This card is required for entrance into the library, the bookstore and other buildings on campus. Bring a copy of your paid bill and proof of identification (driver's license or school ID) with you.

## 11. Affidavit of Residency

If you are a New York State resident for a minimum of one year, but have not resided in Nassau County for at least six months, you are eligible for Nassau County's tuition rate. Contact the Office of Admissions for your residency form.
