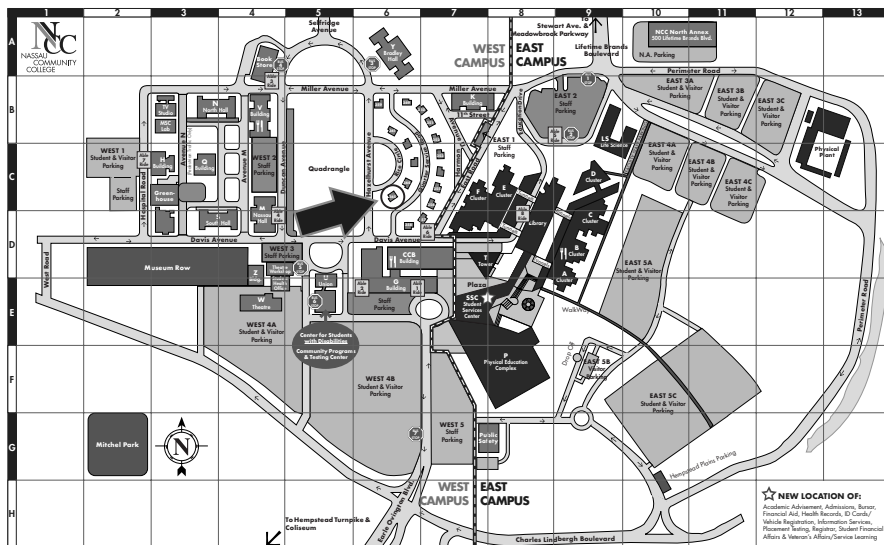

- Montgomery GI bill (Chapter 30)
- Montgomery GI Bill Selected Reserve (Chapter 1606)
- Post-Vietnam Era (Chapter 32)
- Voc Rehab for vets who have 10% service connected disability (Chapter 31) To apply, submit a completed application (VA Form 28-1900) to the nearest VA office.
- Dependents Benefits (Chapter 35)

___ Go to www.va.gov or www.vabenefits.vba.va.gov/vonapp/ or www.gibillva.gov (VONAPP-Veterans on line application).

Please note: A Certificate of Eligibility will be sent to you after you complete and submit your application on-line). Additional questions regarding veterans benefits please call the VA 1-888-442-4551. Veterans can check his ebenefits <https://www.ebenefits.va.gov/ebenefits/homepage> to see if GI Bill has been updated (print off and bring in to SCO) and you can also check how much time you have left on your GI Bill.

___ Military and Immunizations – Proof of all immunizations measles, mumps, rubella and meningitis survey (if taking 6 or more credits) must be brought to Health Services Student Services Center or go online www.ncc.edu/healthoffice; or call (516) 572-7123.

___ Placement Testing www.ncc.edu/placementtesting (516) 572-7780. *Must have a current and valid driver's license, passport or HS identification.

___ If you want to use your GI Bill, you submit a copy of your "Member 4" DD214 and you must provide the Certificate of Eligibility to the Certifying officials in the Student Services Center. You must meet with Ms. Annette Walsh (email: Annette.Walsh@ncc.edu phone: (516) 572-7131 x24908) or Ms. Ellen La Manna (email: Ellen.LaManna@ncc.edu phone: (516) 572-7131 x24907) or call the Veteran Line (516) 572-7368. (**Note: You have to meet with certifying officials every semester so you could be recertified.**) Order your Military Transcripts at: <https://jst.doded.mil/smart/signIn.do> so we can evaluate it to see if we can transfer in college credits

___ Tuition/fees can be paid at the Bursar's Office located in the Student Services Center.

___ Student ID can be obtained in the Student Services Center (must have valid passport or driver's license) after tuition, fees and all charges are paid (either covered by financial aid or veterans benefits).

___ All students must have a valid vehicle registration for parking on NCC campus, you may register at www.ncc.edu/campuservices

___ Textbooks can be purchased at NCC's Bookstore (516) 222-7066 www.nccbncollege.com. Some books may be available to you provided by student veterans who have returned them to the Veterans Resource Facility located at 365 Rice Circle for other student veterans to use. You can also use Amazon Textbooks, CHEGG (rental website).

___ **Meet and Greet** for incoming veterans is conducted a week before classes start. Location and time will be sent through email or postcard. Meet with administrators and staff. Have your questions answered.
