This will give students the ability to use watercolor in transparent, translucent or opaque techniques. Students are free to paint any subject they like. Test fabric will be provided to start you off, and by the last two sessions we will complete an apron and a reusable shopping bag. Please bring your own sewing machine to class. A supply list will be provided prior to the start of class.

QUILT IN A DAY! (CE9 701 A1)

This is a great class to teach the basics of quilting, but a background in sewing is a must! We will make a 54" x 60" Rail Fence "throw" size quilt. We will cut, stitch together the top, using a technique called 'strip piecing', then we will layer the back, the batting and the quilt top all together - quilt, and then add the binding, all in a 3 hour class. Please bring to class: your own sewing machine (sewing machine must be able to 'drop feed dogs' and have a quilting presser foot), rotary cutter, ruler, and self-healing mat, 1.25 yards of 45" wide cotton fabric in three different colors, half yard of cotton for binding, 3 yards of muslin or broadcloth for backing, and a 54" x 60" batting.
