ELIGIBILITY INFORMATION

Workforce development training courses are currently available for free through Nassau Community College's Office of Workforce Development and Lifelong Learning.

To be eligible for a scholarship, you must meet basic requirements including:

- Be an unemployed or under-employed Nassau County resident
- Be at least 17 years of age
- Have earned a high school diploma or equivalent for workforce training opportunities*
- Have access to a computer and Wi-Fi (courses may have a remote learning components)
- Meet HUD income eligibility requirements (determination will be based on documentation provided with your application). Income eligibility is based on the number of members in your household and the total income of <u>all</u> the members of the household. Please submit your income documents after blacking out personal identification information such as a Social Security number.
- Have not received a prior Workforce Development scholarship one scholarship per student.

If you are eligible to receive a scholarship, you must be available to come to our office for a brief interview.

If your plans change after being awarded a scholarship, you must notify our office at least seven (7) days **before** the course begins.
