APPLICATION PROCESS:

All materials for an application must be submitted by the application deadline to be considered.

- For students who will be first entering the college, or students who attended and are not currently in attendance, apply by going to the NCC home page (NCC.EDU) and click the orange "Apply Now" tab. Select the proper application for Degree-Seeking students.
- For students that have attended as a Non Degree Seeking or Visiting student apply by going to the NCC home (NCC.EDU) and click the orange "Apply Now" tab. Select the proper application for Degree-Seeking students.
- For those who are currently attending NCC in another program of study, a **Request to Transfer into the Physical Therapist Assistant Program** should be submitted by using the in house transfer form.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students with no college credits

• **High School Diploma** Grades of 75 or better is required in high school biology, chemistry and two years of mathematics. Regents' courses are required. (For New York State residents only).

Students with college credits for NCC or transfer student:

- Completion of at least 12 liberal arts credits from the Physical Therapist Assistant Program with an average of 2.5 or above. If chemistry was not completed in high school, a semester of introductory college chemistry is required, and may be counted as part of the 12 liberal arts credits.
- Grade of C+ or better in AHS 131 (Anatomy and Physiology I) and enrolled in or completion of AHS 132 is necessary to apply. If an applicant does not have Anatomy & Physiology two Science majors' course such as biology, chemistry or physics, with grades of C+ or better, may be substituted

ALL APPLICANTS:

• **10 hours or more** of volunteer or paid work in a physical therapy setting documented on letterhead and signed by a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant. More than one letter may be submitted documenting any and all physical therapy experience.

Please be advised that to be employed in New York State all graduate physical therapist assistants must pass a licensing examination and be certified by the state. Upon successful completion of the program, when you apply for certification as a Physical Therapist Assistant, you will be required to show evidence of your current name and any previous names you have used, any criminal records, and your citizenship or legal status in the United States.
