You will visit Bale National Park and study its diverse life zones and its rare Afro-alpine fauna and flora. Then you will travel to Nachisar National Park and observe the fauna of a rift valley lake. Then you will visit Awash National Park, its many mammals, including monkeys and many birds.

**Qualifications:**

- Must have 15 credits completed prior to application.
- Must have completed all remedial courses prior to application.
- Must have completed BIO 101 and 102 or BIO 109 and 110.
- Must have a 2.5 GPA or permission of instructor.
- Prospective students must be interviewed by faculty member and Study Abroad Coordinator before being admitted to the class.

**Cost:** About \$4,000 (airfare, all land travel, all accommodations, all entrance fees and guides, all breakfasts and dinners), plus tuition.
